Project Location: Various Locations in Florida

UESI performed, and is continuing to perform marine support for statewide submarine cable repairs, including installing cable warning signs in waterways. Marine support includes supply of barges, vessel and personnel to lift submarine cables and support the client cable splicing crews. A typical repair requires a quick response and comprises loading client splicing equipment and cable reel (20,000 lbs) aboard an appropriate marine plant (barges), locating cable failure, uncovering cable and lifting cable onto deck without damage. After repairs are made by splicing crews, cable is placed on bottom and buried. Other tasks include replacing signs marking cable locations, transporting bucket trucks on barges to access difficult-to-reach areas and cutting through existing seawalls to provide access for cables. Work locations can range from wetlands to major inlets.
