


National Park Buoy Installation



Project Location: Gulf of Mexico, Monroe County, Florida

Underwater Engineering Services, Inc. (UESI) furnished and installed 48 mooring and boundary buoys throughout the Dry Tortugas National Park. Buoys were placed to serve as moorings for dive and research vessels, to mark research and historic areas and to mark areas closed for use. Bottom conditions were sand or rock that required the foundations to utilize a combination of Manta anchors or drilled and grouted anchors to attach buoys. Water depths ranged from 5 feet to 90 feet of water. Stringent environmental controls were required during construction to negate impact to this fragile ecosystem, located approximately 70 miles West of Key West.
