Construction – Navigational Aids

Project Location: San Marcos De Apalache Historic State Park, Florida

UESI installed five navigational signs in the St. Marks River along the San Marcos De Apalache Historic State Park's shoreline. The work included driving 40-foot-long timber piles and securing sign panels to the piles. The piles had to be driven through areas of hard rock to achieve desired depths. The job required a drilling rig to drill through the hard rock and a pontoon vessel with an A-frame to drive the piles. The site was located in a sensitive environmental area and required strict construction methods protect the existing site.
